WHY THIS INFORMATION

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter "Regulation"), this page describes the personal data processing methods by users browsing the websites of GR Elettronica s.r.l. (hereinafter "GR"). They can be accessed on-line at the following address: www.greletronica.it.

This information does not concern other websites, pages or on-line services accessible through hyperlinks, if any, which are published on the websites but which refer to resources outside GR's domain.

DATA CONTROLLER

Any browsing of the website may result in the processing of data related to identified or identifiable individuals.

TYPES OF PROCESSED DATA AND PURPOSES OF DATA PROCESSING

Navigation data

IT systems and software procedures allowing the operation of this website acquire - in the ordinary course of operation - personal data whose transmission is implied in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of any computers and terminals used by users, the URI/URL (Uniform Resource Identifier/Locator) notation addresses of required resources, the request time, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file received as a response, the numeric code showing the status of the server response (success, error etc.) and further parameters related to the user's operating system and IT environment.

Such data is needed in order to use the web services and is also processed in order to:

- collect statistical information on any services used (most visited pages, number of visitors per day or time band, geographical areas of origin etc.);
- ensure the proper operation of any services provided.

Navigation data does not persist for more than seven days and is erased immediately after its aggregation, unless the Judicial Authority needs to investigate any offences.

Data disclosed by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary supply of email to GR's contact addresses, and the filling in and submitting of any forms included in the corporate website entail the acquisition of the sender's contact data as needed to respond to them as well as of any personal data included in the communications.

Specific information notices will be published in the pages of GR's website as designed for special services.

Cookies and other tracking systems

No cookies are used to profile the users and no other tracking methods are used.

Session (non-persistent) cookies are used in a way that is strictly limited to what is necessary for a safe and efficient navigation of the websites. The storage of session cookies on terminals or browsers is subject to the

user's control, if information on the cookies is stored on service logs on the servers at the end of HTTP sessions. Storage time shall not exceed seven days, as is the case with the other navigation data.

DATA RECIPIENTS

The website is administered directly by GR Elettronica and the domain is hosted by ARUBA S.p.A.

Therefore Aruba, as the provider of development and maintenance services of the web platform, is the recipient of any data collected following the browsing of the websites listed above.

Any personal data collected is also processed by GR's staff, who act according to specific instructions on the processing methods and purposes.

RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

The data subjects are entitled to be granted by GR, in the cases provided for by the law, access to their personal data. They also have the right to correct or erase such data, to restrict the processing of any data related to them, and to object to data processing (Articles 15 et seq. of the Regulation). RIGHT OF COMPLAINT

Should the data subjects deem the processing of their personal data through this website to infringe the provisions of the Regulation, they are entitled to either lodge a complaint against GR Elettronica, as specified in Art. 77 of the said Regulation, or to take legal action in the competent courts (Art. 79 of the Regulation).
